

By-Law Proposal for the SDHSRA

Add one Regional Rodeo Weekend to be held in late March or Early April Indoors

Point system will remain the same

- Take your best 3 rodeos to state
- NW and SW region to compete in 1 location
- River and East region to compete in 1 location
- May have 2 performances per day or 1 performance per day.
- If 1 performance per day, each region will tabulate points as if co-sanctioned, and will be applied to that person's competing region.
 - Joe from the SW region places 1st in Bareback, Jim from NW region places 2nd in Bareback. Each will receive 10 points for placing first in their individual competing region.

A committee will need to come forward to plan these rodeos. Committees will need to be found to hold these rodeos in each of the 2 combined regions. If committees and locations are not found in any one location, no additional rodeos will be held in any location.

Edit Article VII SDHSRA By-Laws to read:

B. To promote fair and equal competition and to equalize the number of contestants, the Board of Directors shall have the authority to designate the regional rodeo at which a school may participate. Each regional rodeo shall be considered to be two (2) separate rodeos. First Weekend - Saturday #1 Rodeo, Sunday #2 Rodeo, Second Weekend - Saturday #3 Rodeo, Sunday #4 Rodeo (Change 9-26-2015), Third Weekend – Saturday #5 Rodeo, Sunday #6 Rodeo (or 2 rodeos in one day may apply for March/April rodeos) Contestants are eligible to enter any or all rodeos of choice, either 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or a combination of any six rodeos.
