- 2. At least one scholarship will be awarded to a member from each region.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

 Applicant must be member of SDHSRA. Applicant must submit completed application postmarked by <u>Saturday, May 6th, 2023.</u> Please mail, or email application to SDHSRA Secretary Ann Sundermann PO BOX 303 Baltic, SD 57003

- 2. Remember, no late applications will be considered.
- 3. Applicant must have enrolled or demonstrate bona fide intention of enrolling in a college, university, or vocational school, excluding correspondence school.

AWARD CRITERIA

Award recipients will be notified of their award. Recipients of the scholarships will be required to meet the following criteria to receive payment of scholarship:

- 1. Recipient must be enrolled and in good standing in college, university or vocational school.
- 2. Proof of enrollment from school must be attached to notice. Payment will be made to the recipient, requiring endorsement by both parties.
- 3. Failure to meet requirements during this time period means scholarship winner will have scholarship revoked. The Scholarship Selection Committee will then award the scholarship to the alternate; provided the alternate meets the same criteria.
- 4. The recipient information and presentation will be presented at the SDHSRA State Finals award ceremony in Fort Pierre, SD on June 17, 2023.
- 5. Scholarships will be awarded during the second (2nd) semester of enrollment, and will expire 1 year after the 2nd semester.
- 6. The NHSRA scholarship winners will mail proof of enrollment to the NHSRA with the appropriate claim form, available on the nhsra website.
