





## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION for

## South Dakota High School Rodeo Association Scholarships Western South Dakota Buckaroos Scholarships and Western Legacy Foundation Scholarships for SDHSRA

This application will be used for ALL THREE Scholarship Programs. The Scholarship Selection Committee will meet at the SDHSRA Finals and will select the recipients of all Scholarships.

## SOUTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. Consists of eight (8) \$500 scholarships
- 2. Two scholarships (one senior boy/one senior girl) will be awarded in each region of the SDHSRA
- 3. Scholarship funds will be awarded during the 3rd semester of College/Technical School.
- 4. Applicant MUST participate in College Rodeo during the first semester of College/Technical School. Proof of participation will be necessary to receive funds.

## WESTERN SOUTH DAKOTA BUCKAROOS RODEO SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. Consists of six (6) \$1500 scholarships and one (1) \$2000 scholarship
- 2. Three \$1500 scholarships will be awarded to three senior girls. An alternate will be selected.
- 3. Three \$1500 scholarships will be awarded to three senior boys. An alternate will be selected.
- 4. One \$2000 scholarship will be awarded to the top applicant (boy or girl).
- 5. Scholarship funds will be awarded during the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of College/Technical School.
- 6. Applicant MUST participate in College Rodeo during the first semester of College/Technical School. Proof of participation will be necessary to receive funds.

## WESTERN SOUTH DAKOTA BUCKAROOS NON-RODEO SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Consists of one (1) \$2000 scholarship
- 2. Awarded to a senior boy or girl with an immediate family member who is/was a member in good standing of the Western South Dakota Buckaroos. This includes departed and current Buckaroos. Immediate family members include grandfathers, fathers or brothers.
- 3. An alternate will be selected.
- 4. The PERSONAL STATEMENT for this scholarship is required to be 500 WORDS in length.
- Applicants WILL NOT interview at the SDHSRA Finals. Interviews will be completed via Zoom or Facetime on JUNE 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2024. Applicants will be contacted via phone 15 minutes prior to interview so should plan to be available all afternoon on June 7<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. This scholarship DOES NOT require participation in High School or College Rodeo

#### WESTERN LEGACY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Consists of two (2) \$2000 scholarships
- 2. One scholarship will be awarded to a senior girl. Alternate will be selected. One scholarship will be awarded to a senior boy. Alternate will be selected.
- 3. These scholarships DO NOT require participation in college rodeo.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

- Applicants must be senior members of the SDHSRA and qualify for the SDHSRA State Finals

   ONE EXCEPTION: Western South Dakota Buckaroos Non-Rodeo Scholarship
- 2. Applicants must submit a completed application via email or postmarked by TUESDAY, MAY 28<sup>TH</sup>, 2024
- 3. Applications should be MAILED or EMAILED to:

- 4. If EMAILING application, scan all documents and send in ONE file, NOT individual scans. Must be emailed by May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024
- 5. If MAILING application, it MUST be post-marked ON or BEFORE May 28th, 2024
- 6. Personal Statement STILL NEEDS TO BE HAND WRITTEN, even if emailing application.
- 7. Absolutely NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Send it assuming you WILL qualify for the State Finals.
- 8. ALL eligible applicants must appear before the Scholarship Committee for a personal interview on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at the SDHSRA Finals in Fort Pierre, SD.
  - a. Interviews will be held 8:00 am 2:00 pm at the Expo Center, north of the Grandstands.
  - b. Any changes of time or location will be posted.
- 9. Applicants must have enrolled or demonstrate bona fide intension of enrolling in a college, university or vocational school. Correspondence schools are not acceptable.

#### AWARD COLLECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Scholarship winners will receive a certificate to be awarded on Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 1:00 PM CST at the Stanley County Fairgrounds in Fort Pierre, SD.
- 2. To receive payment of scholarships, recipients must:
  - a. Be enrolled and in good standing in college, university or vocational school.
  - b. Recipient is responsible for contacting scholarship's sponsoring organization for payment.
    - i. Proof of enrollment must be included.
    - ii. Western SD Buckaroo Scholarship Checks will be made out to BOTH School and Recipient, requiring endorsement by BOTH parties.
    - iii. SDHSRA Scholarship Checks will be made out to recipient.
- 3. Buckaroo and SDHSRA Scholarship winners must show enrollment for 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester of School
  - a. Buckaroo Scholarship winners have two (2) years to claim the scholarship from date they are eligible to collect.
  - b. SDHSRA Scholarship winners have one (1) year to claim scholarship from date they are eligible to collect.
  - c. Western Legacy Scholarships must be used by the Spring Semester of the following year received. Requirements must be sent in by Jan 1, 2025. Funds will be dispersed for the 2025 Spring Semester.
- 4. Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in revocation of scholarship.
  - a. Alternate will then be awarded scholarship monies provided they meet the required criteria.
- 5. Certificates presented at the time of the award ceremony will contain information on collection of scholarship monies, the contact personnel and the appropriate time frame. These contacts will also be posted on the sdhsra.com website under Forms > Scholarships.
