

GUIDELINES FOR SDHSRA REGIONAL RODEOS

Work force at rodeo: paid by host

1. Announcer
2. 2 recorders-one for each arena
3. 5 timers-2 for each arena and one for cutting
4. Tractor and driver, with associated equipment
5. 3 workers to sort and load timed event stock
6. Announcer in the cutting, reined cow horse, rodeo arenas
7. Secretary/camera person in cutting arena
8. Flagger in cutting arena
9. Gate openers in each arena
10. 2 workers in the timed event stripper pen
11. 2 workers in the goat arena
12. 2 workers for reined cow horse contest
13. 1 goat holder
14. 2 workers to untie calves
15. 1 arena cleaner/timed events and reined cow horse

Judges

1. 2 rough stock judges
2. 2 timed event judges
3. 2 cutting judges
4. 1 reined cow horse judge
5. Reined cow horse scribe, if not provided by judge
6. All judges will be furnished with motel room arranged and paid by host committee
7. Judges will be selected and secured by the host committee
8. Judges must conform to NHSRA rulebook and SDHSRA ground rules

Bullfighters and pick up men - selected and paid by host

1. 2 bullfighters
2. 2 pick up men

Equipment (host)

1. 4 – 3 digit stop watches, eye and printer or output transfer cable
2. 4 flags/ judges
3. 3 regulation barrels
4. 6 regulation poles
5. Barriers
6. Roping box pads
7. Office facility and equipment needed by the regional secretary

Admissions

1. Admission for host site personnel
2. Ticket and gate prices-negotiable item
3. Ticket takers, security as needed and personnel
4. Registration Personnel as needed

Ambulance

1. One on site-one on call, equipped with AED (9/2017)
2. One livestock ambulance
3. Available for cutting, reined cow horse, queen and rodeo performances

Awards-furnished by host

1. Regionals-prizes to be comparable within the region
2. Staff to present prizes

Programs

1. Annual point systems, award dedications, and SDHSRA sponsors as provided by the state secretary, will be included
2. To be compiled in such a way as to promote the sponsors and promote the sdhsra

Stalls

1. Adequate stalls for penning area on grounds
2. Adequate watering facilities for livestock

Stock contractors must conform to NHSRA rulebook and SDHSRA ground rules

1. Stock bids should be presented to the host committee for cutting cattle, goats, rough stock, timed event stock and reined cow horse stock
2. Host responsible for all cutting cattle, goats, rough stock, timed event stock and reined cow horse stock
3. Inspection to ensure livestock is healthy by host

Motels and restaurants (within a 30 mile radius of site)

1. Availability of motels
2. Availability of restaurants and hours of operation during the event
3. Camper facilities
4. Complimentary room(s) for secretaries/ one for sports medicine personnel

Bid considerations

1. Regionals-\$250 minimum
2. Each regional rodeo will pay \$150 toward the single queen contest expenses (9/17)

Concessions

1. Concession stand furnished and on grounds
2. Prices and service must conform to family orientation

Dances/Activities

1. If hosting a dance/event the host shall furnish music, chaperones and security

Arena conditions

1. Rodeo office and phone on grounds or cell capability, internet service may be a consideration
2. Queen facilities-if hosted at regional contest
3. Adequate lights and electricity
4. Furnish a pa system
5. Adequate panels-for turn back fence and cutting events

Committee structure shall consist of:

1. Members of host committee, with voting rights on the committee, who shall organize and conduct the regional rodeo
2. Sdhsra regional secretary, to be reimbursed by the host committee

Failure to meet requirements during two-year contract will make said contract null and void for remainder of contract.

Facilities and final contracts for the Regional and State sites shall be approved by the State Directors (9/2008) Regional Rodeos must be held within the Regional Boundaries set by the State Directors (9/2017)
