## **SDHSRA Refund Policy**

No money will be refunded after the regional application has been submitted, except for a medical reason that is documented by an MD or PA. Original, signed documentation must be provided from an MD or PA. Contestant must provide original written documentation to the SDHSRA Regional or Executive Secretary, and specifically request refund, following the refund policy guidelines. (Change 9-25-2021)

The regional rodeo entry applications must be submitted on or before the deadline set by the Board of Directors. (Change 9-28-19) There are no exceptions to the standards established by this paragraph.

## Refund Policy Guidelines:

- Medical Release must be submitted, complete and in its entirety, no later than the first day of the first Regional Rodeo.
  \*Note the first day of the Regional Rodeo may be the day the Cutting, RCH and/or Queen competitions are held. Refund requests will not be accepted or given after this time.
- Payment/Reimbursement by the Regional Rodeo, to the contestant, must be made no later than one month from the date of submission of the request.
- Once a member has requested a Regional Rodeo medical release and a refund, the contestant will not be allowed to medical back in, in the given High School Rodeo season.
- If a contestant would like to medical out of some event(s) but not all events, the refund will not be granted.
- The contestant can drop events without a refund prior to the close of registration, as ground rules indicate.
- The SDHSRA Practice Rodeo committees will decide for their rodeos if refunds will be granted or not, there is no requirement for them to do so.
