SDHSRA SAFETY POLICY

Rodeo Medical

Each REGIONAL (point qualifying) OR PRACTICE RODEO shall submit the current activity approval form to the SDHSRA no later than December 15th.

The information provided on that form shall indicate the following:

RODEO SITE

NEAREST HOSPITAL

TELEPHONE NUMBER AND ADDRESS OF NEAREST HOSPITAL OR URGENT CARE FACILITY

NAME, EMAIL AND PHONE NUMBER OF THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE RODEO

SECRETARIES EMAIL, ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER

The forms will be kept by the State Secretary and approved by the SDHSRA Board of Directors.

It is required by the SDHSRA that there be an ambulance on grounds at all SDHSRA and SDJHRA sanctioned rodeos. The ambulance must have an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) on Board, along with First Aid equipment and equipment necessary to maintain an emergency airway.

Rodeo, Animal

Each Rodeo will post the animal safety policy at either the contestant check in area or stalling area, if there is a designated stalling area.

Each Rodeo Secretary shall have the phone number of the nearest Veterinarian available in the Rodeo Office.

Rodeo, Contestant Safety

A safety check that has been approved by the SDHSRA Board of Directors will be held prior to the rodeo for Rough Stock events, and any other event deemed necessary by an SDHSRA Director or Rodeo Committee.
