Course of Fire: The Two-Person Team Match (up to 2- 2 person teams per state or province plus a total of 2 alternates) and the Family Fun Event will consist of 25 birds from the 16-yard line.

Both team members will shoot one round of trap (25 birds) each. Each team will be assigned a flight and start time.

Shoot-off: A shoot-off will begin immediately upon conclusion of the final relay if necessary.

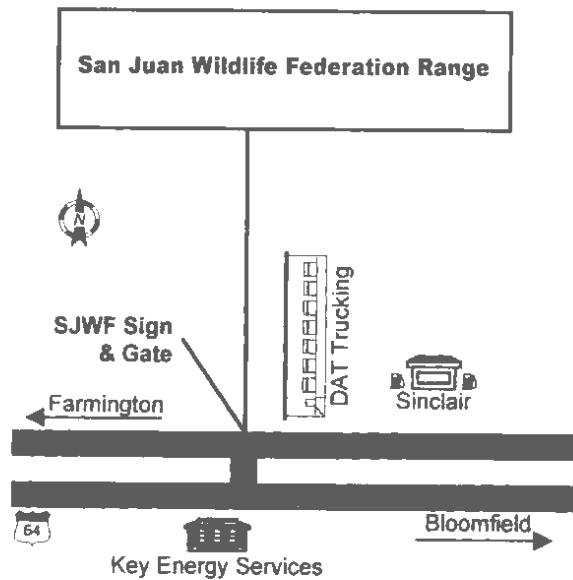
Rules: Amateur Trapshooting Association Rules will apply. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all competitors while on the field.
