GENERAL INFORMATION:

- ✓ Each contestant gets a free program at the time of registration. All other programs will cost \$1.
- ✓ Contestants will run in reverse order on Sunday.
- ✓ You will need your contestant number to get through the gate without paying.
- ✓ Admission: Children ages 11 and under are admitted free when accompanied by an adult.
Ages 12 and over: \$12 wristband for all three days OR
Cutting \$4, Sat and Sun \$7 per performance

2010 Important Ground Rules that May Affect your Ability to Compete

A Non Notified Turn out or No Show cannot go and compete at state finals. They can, however, show up and compete at the other rodeos, but will not be eligible for State.

A Notified Turn Out - example (vet, medical, flat tire, another reason...) is eligible to compete in the other events if they have notified you before the end of registration for that rodeo that day. They are eligible to carry all of their points to state and compete there, if they qualify.

*If a family member registers a sibling and the sibling does not compete, it is considered a Non Notified Turn Out.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU: If you do not register before the end of the registration period at any regional rodeo, you will be **unable to compete that day** AND will be **unable to compete at the SDHSRA State Finals in 2010!** In the case of an emergency, call Sandy Buchholz at 605 347 1353 before the end of registration. Call one of the directors below if you are unable to catch Sandy. If you are not competing Saturday but are competing on Sunday, please contact Sandy before Sunday to discuss registration procedures. **If you do register and do not compete in any event in which you registered, it is considered a non notified turn out!**

New eligibility standards from the NHSRA

Students must be passing 70% of classes taking. This translates to the following:

It is final semester grades that will be checked using the criteria given.

Remember to bring an **official 4th quarter report card to Wall**. They will be kept and sent to Sturgis for you. If your 4th quarter report cards are not yet available for Wall, bring your 3rd quarter report card to Wall, but you **MUST** have a 4th quarter report card at Sturgis! If you think this might be a problem, you should be talking to your school officials now to make arrangements. As indicated in the February SDHSRA newsletter, faxes or items run off the student portal will not be accepted for report cards.

Get report cards from your school office and have them stamped or signed by a school official.
