SportsMed Brief By: Patricia Gilbert, PA-C, L/ATC CONCUSSIONS

One of the biggest concerns and topics of discussion in the sports medicine field presently is the traumatic brain injury (TBI) or what we hear as concussion. Over 75% of TBI patients report some physical and mental symptoms over the first several weeks following the injury. Symptoms can include headache, dizziness or vertigo, blurred vision, fatigue, sleep disturbance, irritability, depression, anxiety, and poor memory and concentration. Typically these symptoms improve steadily and are largely cleared after the first three months after injury. However, depression and anxiety can persist longer.

The biggest point of concern is the lack of appropriate initial evaluation along with the follow up with the athlete. New programs for testing athletes pre-season are coming available so that post-testing injury can be compare objectively with pre-injury status. Athletes are not to return to play on game day if any symptoms are present more than 15 minutes after injury. For return to play later, the athlete needs to be symptom free of physical and mental status complaints at rest and remain symptom free following progression into physical activities. Example would be once headache is gone and concentration in the class has come back to normal, athlete is then progressed to jogging for a short distance. If no symptoms the next day, they can continue to progress the athlete with more activity until full play is reached.

Loss of consciousness is not a determinant of time off of sports return. Athletes are to be observed and monitored following a head injury but no longer do we have them waken every two hours during the night. If any worsening of memory, balance, vision, headache, level of consciousness or mental status, athlete should be seen by a physician and testing performed. The head trauma is hard to deal with for health care providers and the athlete since you can not see the injury, get your hands on it to evaluate and no quick tape job or brace will assist in a faster return to play. Fractures, sprains, strains all take time to heal, 4-8 weeks some times. We have to remember that the brain needs time to heal also.

***the Posting of the *Order Draw for State Finals*. State Finals qualifiers will receive their informational packets after they qualify at their perspective regional rodeos. The Draw will not be included in the packet. It will be posted on the SDHSRA website as soon as it is complete. Keep checking the website to see when you will be up.

***SW Director, Dan Curr will be replacing Troy Richter for the remainder of his term. Thank you, Troy, for the support you have given to the SDHSRA.

***Arena Conflicts at State Finals. Should you have an arena conflict, let a SDHSRA Director know and they will work with you and advise you if need be.

***Regional Entry and Practice Rodeo forms will be posted on the internet soon.

***The student officer's chose National Team coats, and the Calendar coat, t shirt and cap awards.

***SW Region—you are in charge of the queen's "basket", or container for the items, this year. Last year the NW Region donated a beautiful chest. All rodeo clubs are encouraged to donate an item to place in the "basket." Bring it to your regional rodeo, or state finals.

If you have calendars that you have not sold, you need to get them to your calendar advisor or Sara Grim immediately!!

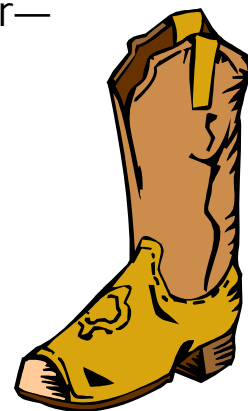
